## Minutes

**GUEST SPEAKER NSW Liquor and Gaming  
Sam Campisi and Dara Khchao**

Meeting Started at 7.30pm and the Vice-President Ken Janson introduced the guest speakers Sam Campisi and Dara Khchao from the Community Access Team of the Liquor and Gaming Department of the NSW Government (LGNSW).

Sam spoke about the function of the Liquor and Gaming NSW which regulates casino, liquor laws, registered club and gaming machines in the state. The LGNSW actively engages with the community to encourage community participation in the licencing process. He explained how communities could be involved in any licence application by providing a submission which would be taken into account when a determination is made based on the merits of the application. He outlined the complaints system based on a form available on the website which related to instances of licence breaches, anti-social behaviour and noise disturbances. He maintained that notified complaints would be investigated and compliance with regulations would be enforced.

There followed a 'Q & A' in which several questions were answered by the representatives. The varied queries involved the large numbers of gaming machines prevalent in the state, gambling addiction, encouragement of electronic gambling during sports shows, gambling restrictions placed on opening hours of licenced premises, lockout laws, etc.

The speakers were thanked for their attendance and informative presentation.
