Thank you a copy of your recent correspondence dated 16 September 2010 regarding Glenrock Parade at Koolewong. The Director City Services has advised that progressive improvement works have been undertaken along Glenrock Parade. Recent works included the construction of a footpath along the northern approach to Tascott Station and a section of kerb and gutter / footpath in the vicinity of Koolewong Station.

The next work to be undertaken will be in the vicinity of the bend at the northern intersection of Nimala Avenue with Glenrock Parade (near House No 189) and will include the construction of a footpath and kerb and guttering. The final design plans for this work are nearing completion and construction is programmed to be undertaken in the coming months.

Further works in Glenrock Parade will be assessed alongside the many other projects throughout Gosford City. Based on the need to establish a better alignment for motorists and suitable pedestrian access facilities in various sections of Glenrock Parade further reconstruction work in this road is considered to warrant a high priority.

Council's Pavement Management Process identifies roads requiring resurfacing and rehabilitation on a network-wide priority needs basis. Glenrock Parade will be considered along with all roads within the Koolewong area for inclusion in a future Road Treatment Program in line with this process. The condition of the road pavement in some sections of Glenrock Parade is expected to warrant a high priority for rehabilitation. In the interim, Council's Maintenance Section will continue to inspect these roads, including Glenrock Parade, for traffic safety and road maintenance issues.
