- 1) Acceptance of Minutes from General Meeting Thursday 11th July, 2024 July 2024 General Meeting Minutes Moved: Ken Janson 2nd. Ian Robb
- 2) Apologies: Margaret Alexander
- 3) Presidents Report: Ken Janson. Ken undated the members on the outcome of the appearance in court recently of the Offender that pushed Ken and his vehicle over the embankment on Glenrock Parade, Tascott and down onto the Northern Rail Line Corridor on October 29th 2023. The Offender ended receiving from his court appearance a sentence of 200 Community Hours.
- 4) Treasurers Report: Ray Lawson. Working Account: \$1662.94. Reserve Account: \$495.81 3 Months Term Deposit 20/11/2024 \$5092.37 11 Months Term Deposit 20/01/2025 \$9000
