GENERAL BUSINESS:

- 1. Sign the Petition for Dangerous Glenrock Parade. 549 Signatures to date call-for-urgent-fix-on-dangerous-glenrock-pde
- 2. Road surface in Glenrock Parade outside House No 423, Point Clare. ACTION: Member requested that Central Coast Council be contacted on her behalf to have the road surface inspected.
- 3. Hold a Community Forum for information on the pre-selection of incoming Councilors for September 2024. ACTION: Discussion was, that if Candidates contacted the Association for a Forum they would be accommodated.
- 4. Austin Butler Reserve Woy Woy: removed from Central Coast Councils Asset Sale.
- 5. Central Coast Council still needs to look into the condition of the high tree in backyard of Point Clare Community Hall. ACTION: Refer again to Central Coast Council our concern for the safety of those using the grass area.
- 6. Brisbane Water Drive Koolewong needs Pedestrian Crossing A working committee needs to be formed by members of Koolewong and Tascott to consult with TfNSW to look into community safety when crossing Brisbane Water Drive outside Koolewong and Tascott Stations. ACTION: This problem seems to be an age demographic problem for the elderly users of Public Transport via Koolewong and Tascott Stations. Ask our Local State and Federal Members to address the issue for Pedestrian Lights to be installed or have the Pedestrian Crossing at Koolewong Station moved further south towards the entrance to Couche Park on Brisbane Water Drive.

7. Perhaps This for Tascott as they have at Cowan Station

Tascott Station Upgrade – Could we have a Pedestrian level Crossing Installed along the same lines as Koolewong Station to bypass the need for the 80 stairs. Maybe speed humps have to be installed outside Tascott Shops on Glenrock Parade. ACTION: Meeting discussed that TfNSW was, into the future eliminating all forms of level crossings in NSW – but we still are working towards a satisfactory outcome in 2024.
